



Wayzata Team and Individual Actions

The Wayzata High School Chess Team invites you to play in an exciting team tournament (4 vs 4) and an individual tournament for extra team players and players without a team. **For preregistration or questions contact Patrick Tang at patrickatang@yahoo.com.** For teams please list your school name, coach if any, team captain, and the four players in USCF rating order. Please bring sets and clocks.

Date/Venue: Saturday, March 23, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Wayzata High School Cafeteria (one level down from the main entrance)

Team Action Format: Four round Swiss. G/30 d5. USCF Regular and Quick rated. Open to teams of 4 players from the same K-12 school or college. Multiple teams from the same school or college are allowed and they will not be paired against each other if possible except for the final round (tournament directors have the final authority to determine the team pairings based on the circumstances). Up to 2 players from the same school district can be included if a K-12 school team cannot field 4 players. Board order is based on the March supplement ratings.

Individual Action Format: Four round Swiss. G/30 d5. USCF Regular and Quick rated. Open to K-12 and college students.

Entry fee: \$5 per player. USCF membership required (\$22 under 16, otherwise \$26)

10:00 a.m. - Round 1

11:30 a.m. - Round 2

12:00 p.m. - Pizza and drinks for sale

1:30 p.m. - Round 3

3:00 p.m. - Round 4

4:30 p.m. - Awards

Up to two half point byes available for round 1 to 3. Must request by round 2.

Prizes: Trophies for top three teams and top board 1, 2, 3 and 4 in the team tournament and top three in the individual tournament. Top elementary team and individual. Additional class trophies may be added depending on turnout. Tie breaker rules will be determined by the TDs.
